Complacency is no longer an option.

There are several Resolutions in the House of Representatives right now, and it can be easy to become discouraged in this political climate. But... In the House of representatives there are 435 Voting Members. It takes 218 for a Majority Vote and 290 for a 2/3 Majority Vote. The numbers are climbing! We need to stay vigilant and continue to contact our Representatives.

H. Res. 23 was reintroduced by Rep. Susan Davis on January 4, 2019. The goal of this resolution is for the Postal Service to “take all appropriate measures to ensure the continuation of door delivery for business and residential customers.” As of today, March 11, 2019, it has 183 bi-partisan Cosponsors. Of the 183, 6 are from Washington. H. Res. 54 was reintroduced on Jan 16, 2019 by Rep. Gerald Connolly (D-VA) expressing that the “United States Postal Service should take all appropriate measures to ensure the continuation of its 6-day mail delivery service.” To date this resolution has obtained 236 bi-partisan Cosponsors, [Susan DelBene \(D-WA-1\)](#), [Denny Heck \(D-WA-10\)](#), [Rick Larson \(D-WA-2\)](#), [Jamie Herrera Beutler \(R-WA-3\)](#), [Derek Kilmer \(D-WA-6\)](#), [Kathy McMorris Rogers \(R-WA-5\)](#), [Pramila Jayapal \(D-WA-7\)](#), [Adam Smith \(D-WA-9\)](#), [Kim Schrier \(D-WA-8\)](#)

H.Res.60 - Expressing the sense of the House of Representatives that the United States Postal Service should take all appropriate measures to restore service standards in effect as of July 1, 2012. Introduced on January 17, 2019 by Davis B McKinley (R-WV) has 152 Co-sponsors currently. H. Res. 33 was introduced by Rep. Steven Lynch (D-MA) stating that “Congress should take all appropriate measures to ensure that the United States Postal Service remains an independent establishment of the Federal Government and is not subject to privatization. **H.R. 33** has 236 bi-partisan Cosponsors. S.Res.99 – Introduced in Senate by Gary Peters(D-MI) on March 7, 2019. “A resolution expressing the sense of the Senate that Congress should take all appropriate measures to ensure that the United States Postal Service remains an independent establishment of the Federal Government and is not subject to privatization.” As of this date only [Patty Murray \(D-WA\)](#) has co-signed this Res. We need to reach out to [Maria Cantwell \(D-WA\)](#) and encourage her to do the same.

New Resolutions to watch.

HR 2478 – Introduced by Derek Kilmer (D-WA) on May 2, 2019 To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide that civilian service in a temporary position after December 31, 1988, may be creditable service under the Federal Employees Retirement System, and for other purposes.

1.Short title-This Act may be cited as the Federal Retirement Fairness Act. 2.Creditable service for temporary employees serving after 1988

(a)In general - Section 8411(3) of title 5, United States Code, is amended by striking performed before January 1, 1989,

(b)Application

The amendment made by subsection (a) shall apply to any individual who is an employee (as that term is defined in paragraph (11) of section 8401 of title 5, United States Code), including temporary employees of the United States Postal Service, or a Member (as that term is defined in paragraph (20) of such section) on or after the date of enactment of this Act. Has one Co-sponsor with 0 from Washington.

H.R. 2382 – Introduced by Peter DeFazio (D-OR) on the 29th of April 2019. To amend title 5, United States Code, to repeal the requirement that the United States Postal Service prepay future retirement benefits, and for other purposes. Currently with 29 Co-sponsors, 0 from Washington.
